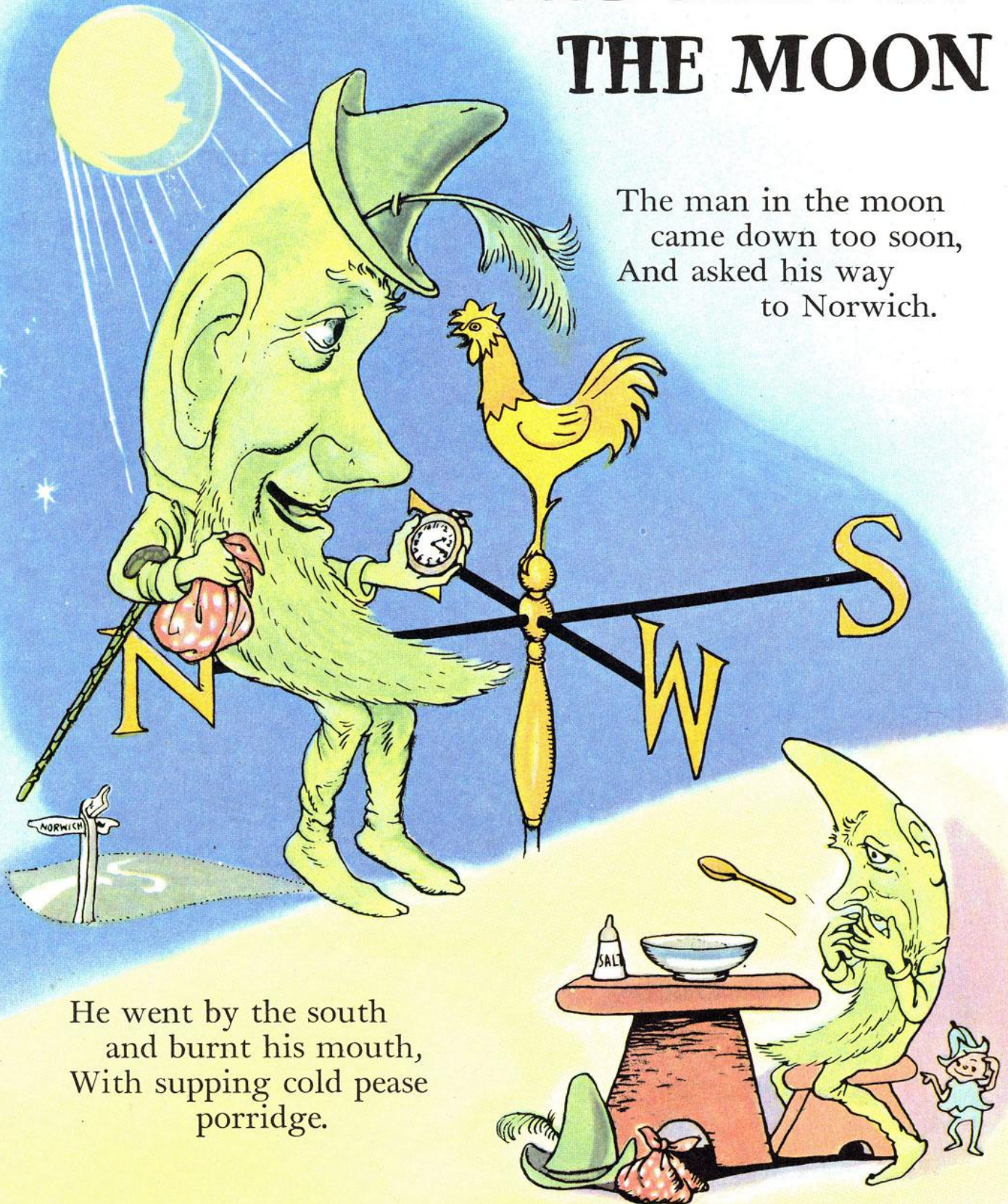

porridge.

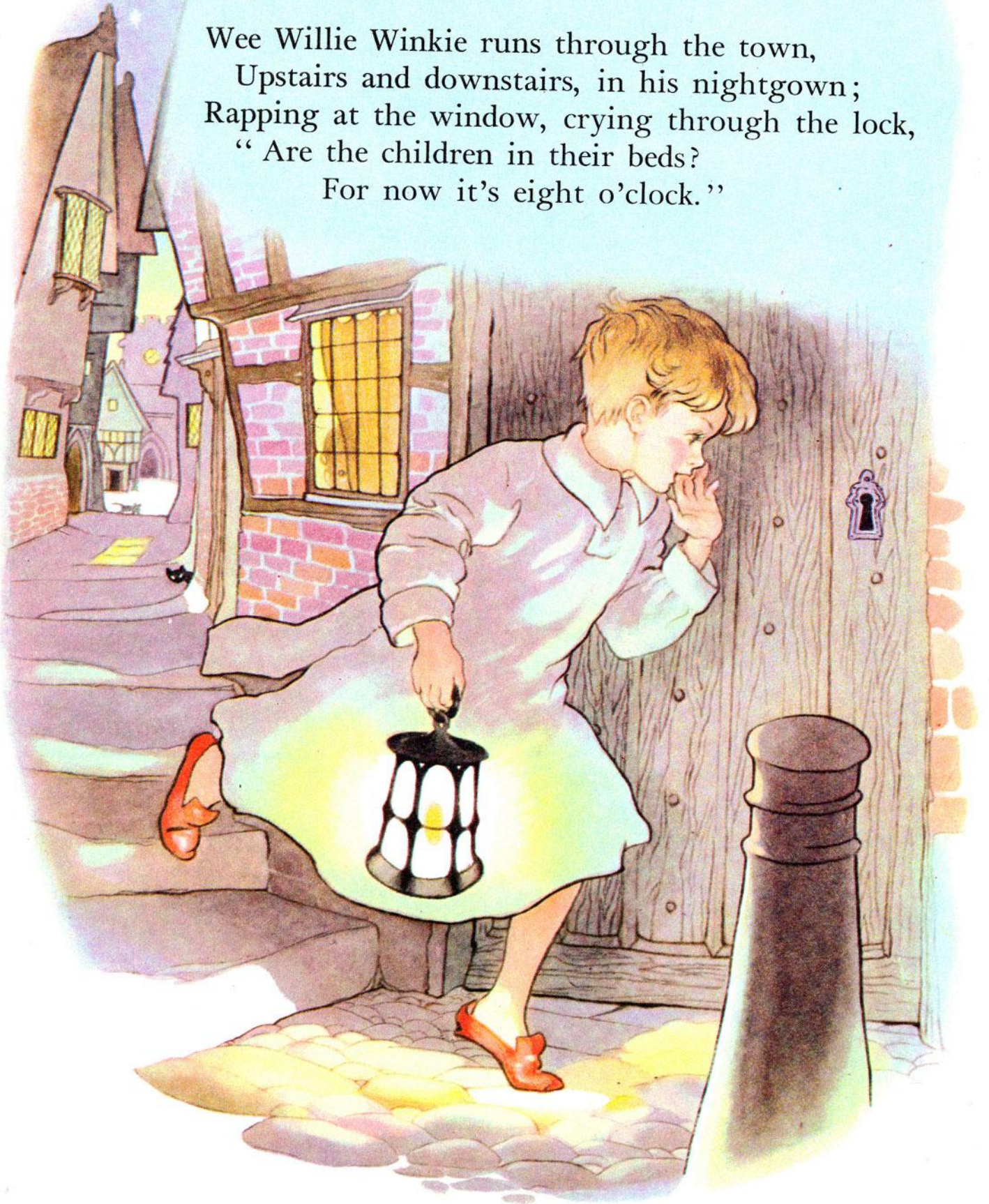
WHAT'S THE NEWS

Is gone up to the moon.



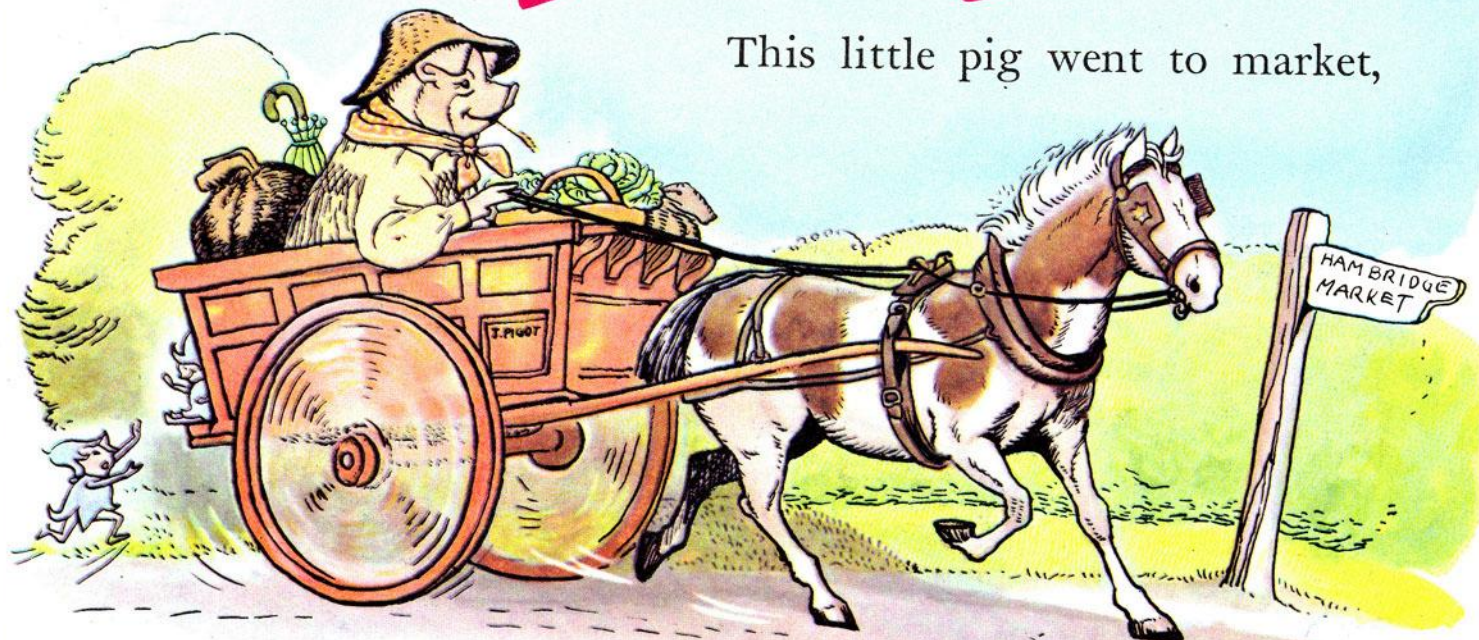
Wee Willie Winkie

For now it’s eight o’clock.”

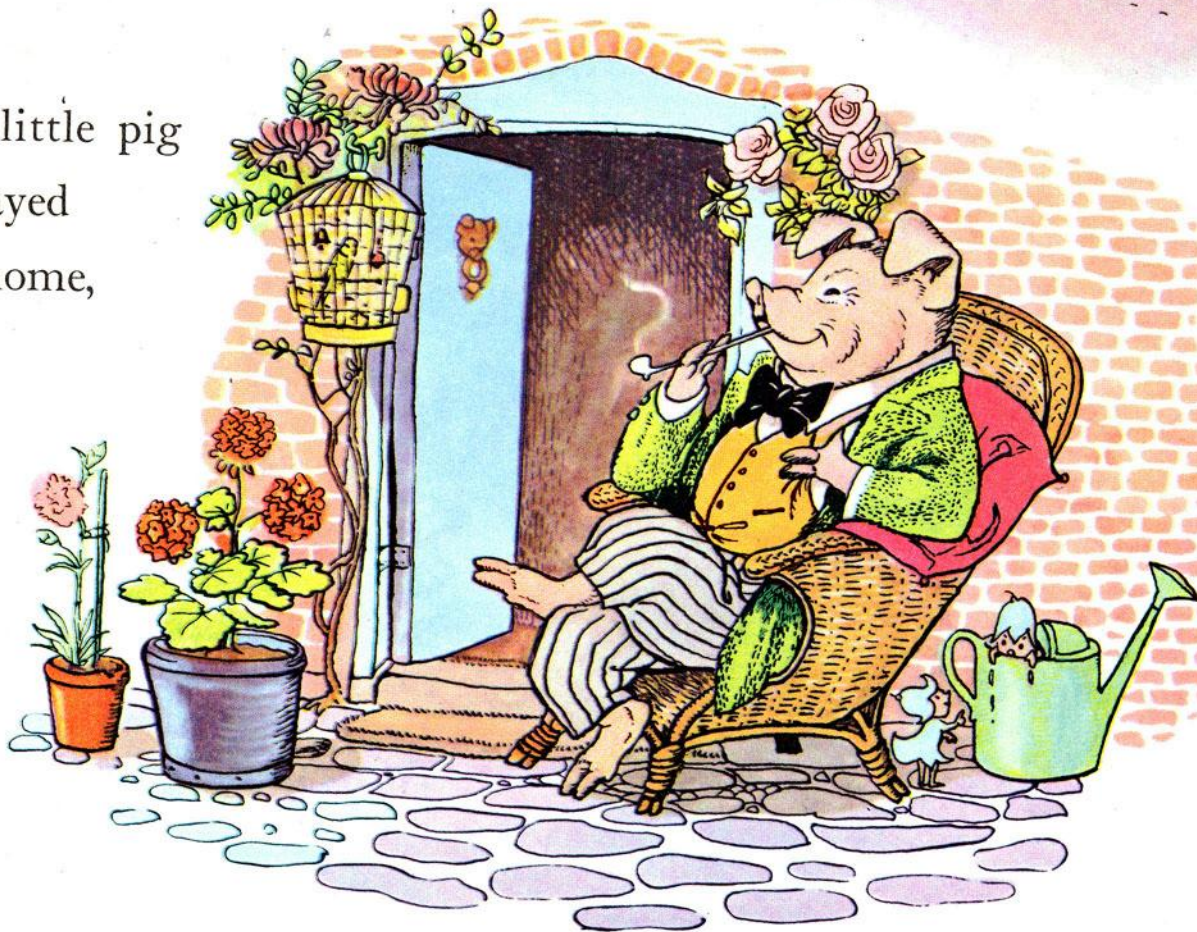


THIS LITTLE PIG

This little pig went to market,



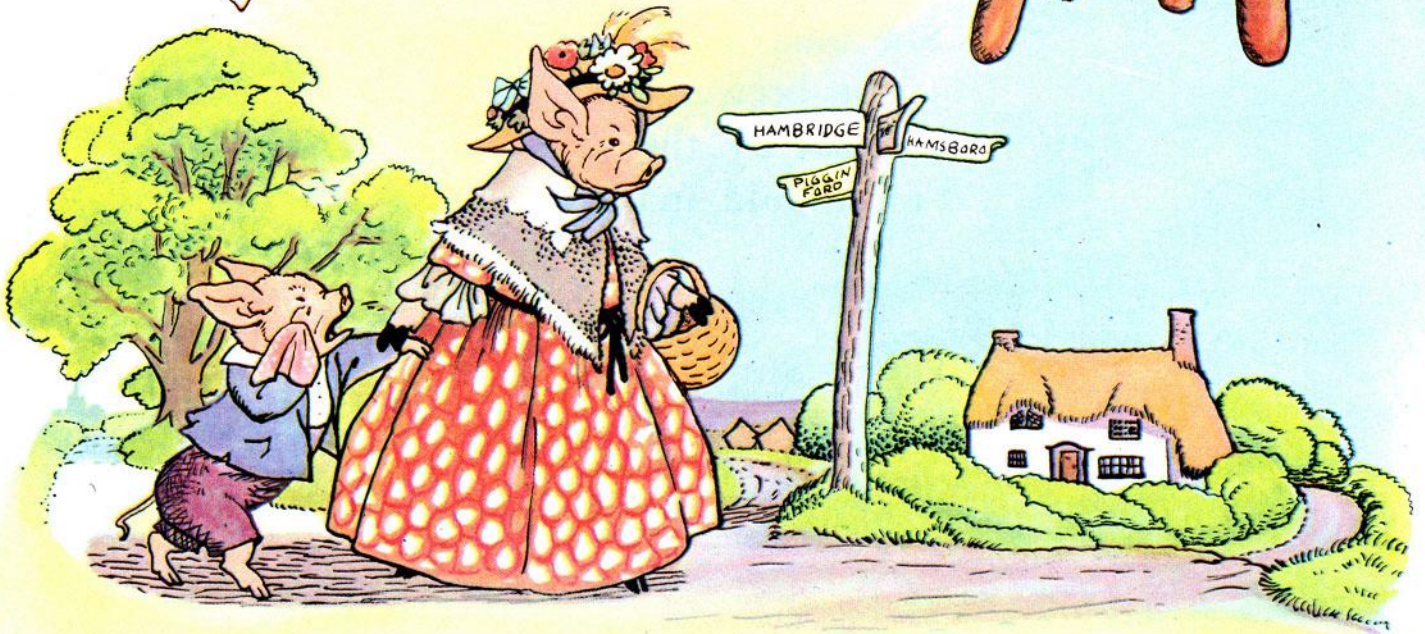
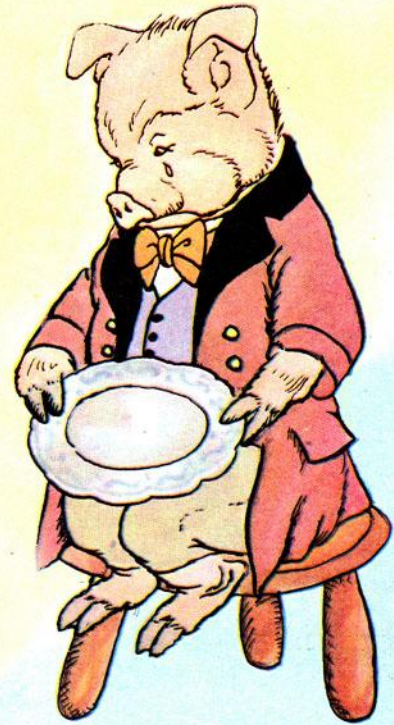
This little pig
